Classroom Spotlight:

Mr. Griffith and Mrs. Johnson Science Classes

The 7th and 8th grade Life Science class has enjoyed discussing the strengths and limitations of science through a biblical Christian worldview. We also are memorizing metric prefixes, characteristics of living organisms, and the taxonomy of classification. Finally, we are performing controlled experiments on bean plants to test if our experimental variable is a factor in plant growth.

The 9th and 10th grade Biology class studied different characteristics of living things and performed a homeostasis experiment on living goldfish—testing the fish's respiration/gill movements when exposed to different temperatures of water. They evaluated and graphed the fish's ability to regulate their respiration. They determined that the warmer the water, the faster the gill movements!!

The 11th and 12th grade Physics class is learning about velocity,

speed, acceleration, and free-fall and how to calculate straight line movement of objects. They performed a laboratory experiment on free-fall acceleration of various weighted objects and are determining if the mass of a falling object increases its acceleration.


